Midland Airpark User,

The City of Midland, Department of Airports, would like to inform you of upcoming construction activities to enhance Midland Airpark's capabilities. This construction includes fully replacing Runway 07/25, Taxiway 'A,' Taxiway 'E,' and Taxiway 'F' to increase the weight-bearing capacity to better support midsize and super-midsize business jet operations. It also includes rehabilitation of Runway 16/34, Taxiway 'B,' Taxiway 'C,' Taxiway 'D,' rehabilitation work on several Aprons, along with new airfield lighting, signage, and NAVAIDS. Surface closures will need to be made during construction to accomplish these exciting upgrades.

Runway 16/34 is anticipated to close on **01/20/2025** to allow for a temporary relocation of the Runway 16 threshold. We anticipate this initial closure lasting two weeks and leaving Runway 16/34 with a temporary length of 2,891' during the remainder of the project. Runway 07/25 is anticipated to close on **02/02/2025**. We anticipate this closure lasting five to six months, as this phase involves a complete runway and taxiway replacement.

To help keep Airpark users informed, we have established a website page that will be updated weekly once construction begins. Pilots are also encouraged to check NOTAMS regularly. The QR codes at the bottom of the page will take you to applicable web pages.

We appreciate your cooperation during this project and understand the inconvenience that large projects may cause.
